Extended Day Program

Available to 3 and 4 year olds who attend morning sessions. Stay for lunch, fun and educational activities. Program also includes rest time, snack, and outdoor play. Ends at 2:45 pm. Available 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 days.

Early Drop Off Program

Available to all ages who attend morning or all day sessions. Drop off your child at 8 am and they will be sent to class at their regular time.

Registration Information

REGISTRATION BEGINS JANUARY 3rd

Applications will be accepted from January 3-20. All applications **MUST** be accompanied by a copy of your child's birth certificate and the non-refundable registration fee.

All returning students and siblings will be accepted first. A lottery will be used to fill any remaining spaces with parishioners receiving priority.

If a class has to be cancelled for lack of students, you will be placed in your second choice class.

The registration fee will only be returned if we do not have **ANY** space for your child. You may not get your first choice, but we will place your child in a class where there is room.

Acceptance letters will be sent by the first week of February. Health forms will be sent with acceptance letters and **MUST** be returned by the first day of school.

Note for 2 1/2 year olds: Your child should be potty trained, but may wear pull-ups in case of an accident. We do not have diaper changing facilities, so someone **MUST** be available to come and change your child if needed.
